EXPLORE SAINT PAUL'S CHOIR SCHOOL IN-PERSON

- *Tour:* Schedule a tour of the school for you and your family.
- *Open Houses:* Visit us at one of our Fall or Winter open houses. Meet faculty, students, and learn more about Saint Paul's.
- *Chorister for the Day:* Your son can join us for a full day! He will participate in all classes, rehearsals, and Mass. During the day, he will also audition and complete a brief academic exam.

- *Concert Events:* Throughout the school year, concerts are an essential part of our school identity. You are welcome to attend and hear the boys at their best!
- **Receptions:** For most concert events, we will host receptions either before or after. Keep an eye on your email invites and our social media for details about these small gatherings. They are a great way to meet parents, teachers, and other staff.
- *Mass:* The boys sing the Mass Tuesdays through Fridays at noon and on Sundays at 11:00 am. Come celebrate with us and hear the liturgy with the boys choir.
- **Parent Ambassadors:** Each year, our Parents Guild elects a new parent ambassador to serve as a liaison between prospective parents such as yourself and families that have been at SPCS for years. You will receive a formal introduction early on in your exploration of the Choir School.

NEXT STEPS:

- 3. APPLICATION On the admissions page of the school's website, you can access the FACTS application website. FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION On the school website's admissions page, you can access the FACTS financial aid application. We ask that all families register for financial aid. Please note, verification of your financial aid application and documentation can take two to three weeks.
- **4. Decide Accept or Refuse Admission** Upon submitting your application materials and completing your financial aid application, the school will begin to review your submissions. These will include reviews of your son's audition, interview, and academic strengths assessment, along with your admission and financial aid applications.
- **5. ENROLL COMPLETE AN ENROLLMENT PACKET** Saint Paul's Choir School will return a completed Enrollment Agreement to each applicant's family, including the financial aid offered, scholarships received, and payment plan options.
